

Cookie Statement

What is a cookie?

A text file stores information, such as language preference for a website. A cookie is a small text file that is sent to your computer when you visit a website. Both this website and other parties can place cookies.

When you visit the website again later, this cookie is sent to the website again. This way, the website recognises your browser and, for example, can remember your language preference.

Cookies usually also have an expiry date. For example, some cookies are deleted automatically when you close your browser (so-called session cookies), while others remain on your computer for a longer period of time, sometimes even until you delete them manually (so-called permanent cookies).

What are cookies used for?

This website uses cookies to improve the website's ease of use and performance.

Among other things, we use cookies to ensure that you do not receive or have to enter the same information every time you visit our site. Cookies therefore make browsing the site more pleasant.

Which cookies does this website use?

There are different types of cookies.

ARID GROUP (limited liability company), with registered office at 1831 Machelen, Lambroekstraat 5 box A, and with company number 0823.129.033 (hereafter: ARID), the administrator of this website, uses on www.aridgroup.eu:

- essential cookies: these cookies are required for purely technical reasons for the use of the website and are therefore often referred to as "necessary cookies". This type of cookie ensures that the website or mobile application works properly. Given the technical necessity, these are set as soon as you enter the website. This does not require consent from you as a website visitor and is only subject to a duty of information.
- **Functional cookies**: these cookies are used to offer additional functions and personal settings to you as a user. You may not reject these cookies if you wish to browse our website but they are only placed after a choice has been made regarding the placement of cookies.
